Dear Parents of our 2½ year old dancers,

We are delighted to have your child dancing with us at The Dance Foundation this year! As you may know, our students have spring performances that celebrate their year of learning and dancing together. Our 2½ year old classes will join together in May to participate in their own special performance, entitled *The Lonely Cloud*, complete with costumes and held in The Dance Foundation's Studio Theatre.

We will have two separate performances to accommodate our many 2½ year old classes and ensure adequate seating in the theatre for family members attending. Each class will be assigned to one of the performance times listed below. We will not begin work on these dances until February, as this event is not meant to be the focus of the year, but a natural extension and element of their dance education. The performance itself will be brief and family and friends are invited to enjoy an informal reception with their dancers afterwards. More specific logistical information will be shared in early spring 2019.

**The performances will be held:**

**Friday, May 3, 2019                      4:00 or 5:00pm**

**The performance fee is as follows:**

You may pay the total fee by November 1<sup>st</sup> if you wish, or pay half now and the remaining balance by February 1<sup>st</sup>.

**Total fee for 2½ year old classes: \$70.00**

**First half, due November 1<sup>st</sup>: \$35.00**

This fee covers your child's costume, which is yours to keep, as well as costs associated with the event. If your child is unable to participate in this performance, please notify our office by November 1<sup>st</sup>. Otherwise, a costume will be ordered for your dancer, and you will be obligated for at least half of the performance fee, as stated in our policies.
